

The Education Code, Section 11780, states that all school district employees must have a tuberculin examination upon employment, and every four years thereafter. Volunteers in San Francisco's public schools working directly with students must also comply with this ruling.

It is imperative that we have a copy of the results of your tuberculin (TB) skin test on file. Reports of TB skin test or chest x-rays from private physicians or health facilities are acceptable if taken **after May 31, 2007**. Please attach a copy of the report to this form; we can not return any materials submitted to us.

If you are a San Francisco resident and do not have a private physician, TB tests are available at the locations listed below. Hours vary from center to center so please call to verify. When getting a new TB test you can take this form to a medical provider. **Many locations require an appointment, it is strongly recommended that you call before visiting the below sites!**
